Prerequisites:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Participants must be a minimum of 17 years of age on the date of final assessment- Complete an 800 metre swim in 14 minutes or less in a swimming pool no less than 25 metres (This is to be signed off by a pool lifeguard/pool representative.) <p>Participants must be proficient in the following SLSA awards;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Bronze Medallion/Certificate II in Public Safety (Aquatic Rescue)- Advanced Resuscitation Certificate- Apply (senior) First Aid- Silver Medallion Basic Beach Management- Spinal Management Certificate

Upon successful completion of this course participants will receive the SLSA Gold Medallion (Advanced Lifesaving) Certificate, please note this is an SLSA recognized award but does not come with any nationally recognized units of competency.
