Surf Life Saving Central Coast in partnership with Streets would like to invite all Central Coast and Hunter clubs to enter the 2015-2016 Streets Surf Boat Series.

Please read the following rules and conditions of entry to the series and all entries from clubs will only be accepted with crews agreeing to compete under these competition rules.

Competition Rules:

- On each day of the competition:
 - One representative only from each club to provide the recorders with an 'On Day Entry Form' containing a list of all crews competing on the day. All clubs must adhere to this request and advise all club sweeps. Entries for each round can be forwarded to Jenny Bootle Dukes4@bigpond.com or 0418 493 662 by 5pm the preceding Saturday.
 - This list must be delivered to the recorders between 7.00am and 7.30am. Any entries received after this time will miss the first round of competition on that day.
- Sweep/Team Managers meeting will take place with the referee at each round at 7.45am.
- The gun will be fired at 8.00am sharp to start the first event of the competition. If boats have been marshalled in a timely manner, then it remains the responsibility of the club to be in position and ready to start.
- Rounds:
 - All rounds will run with three (3) heats, with the top seven (7) to go to the final.
 - If less than seven (7) crews in a division, consideration to running a four (4) x boat final.
- On the entry form, competitor's names must be grouped into crews with the division entered and clearly marked. If a club has more than one crew in a division, each crew must be identified with a name eg "Gold", "Rats" etc. and that crew must keep that name for the whole series. This is to eliminate confusion with the point allocation.
- The age limit for men's masters is set at a minimum 160yrs division (no 120yrs crews). Women's are as per State (120ys plus)
- If a club wishes to enter more than one Reserve Crew at each round, there must be a competing A Crew from that Club.
- Double dipping will be allowed. Any crew that withdraws from one of the events on the day of the carnival will forfeit all points for that day.
- Team members will be supplied with a Lycra singlet. This is to be worn during all competition.
- All other regulation as set out in the 35th Edition Surf Life Saving Australia competition manual will apply.
- All clubs are to be aware of the Helmet Policy - [Helmet Policy update](#)



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12. Categories will comprise U19, U23, U23 Ladies, Open Women's, Open Men, Reserves, Masters Women's & Masters Men's.
13. Only Surf Life Saving Central Coast and Newcastle clubs will be eligible to contest the series.
14. Racing order on the day will be; Open Men, Open Women, U19 Men, Reserve, U23 Women, U23 Men, Master Women & Master Men.
15. Officials quota; each club with 3 or more competing crews must supply a minimum of one level 1 accredited official. The referee/chief judge will allocate positions on the day.
16. A copy of the Pointscore System will be available to view at each round.
17. Sweeps accreditation; all sweeps must have their SLSA sweeps accreditation number and SLSA coaching certificate. These numbers must be entered on the entry form. No sweep will be able to compete without both these certificates. (Proof of coaching course attended pre-season must be provided).
18. Any rowers, in excess of the 4 crew members, must be fully entered on the entry form and listed as 'reserve'. These will be at a cost of \$25 each rower.

Note: The elected boat panel or their proxies will address any problems on the day and report back to the referee for direction.

Administration

Entry Fee: \$220.00 (gst inclusive) per crew for the series.

Entry fee includes a T-shirt and Competitor Rash Vest; however this must be received by the closing date. Entries received after the closing date, receive only a Competitor Rash Vest. Shirt sizes must be included on the entry form.

A late entry fee of \$55.00 (gst inclusive) will be charged after the closing date.
