

To all active patrol and water safety club members

Your annual skills maintenance for your Bronze Medallion, SRC, IRB Drivers and IRB Crew have now started!

These need to be completed as soon as possible and before December 1st 2023 to allow the education team time to process your awards or you will not be able to patrol, provide water safety or compete for our club come January 1st, 2024. Bronze/SRC (this applies to both patrol and water safety members and those that qualified in 2022/23 season)

Theory can be completed via eLearning in your members portal. Enrol into either "Bronze Medallion Skills Maintenance" or "Surf Rescue Certificate Skills Maintenance".

IRB Drivers and Crew

All IRB Drivers must attend at least 1-2 skill maintenances sessions to complete set tasks, these are on the first Sat of every month at 8am where to can practice and get your skills assessed by an IRB trainer, if you are unable to attend these please contact Damon Somerfield, Jarryd Edmonds or Matt Fearnley asap and before December 1st 2023, to arrange an assessment on your patrol.


ART

Silver Salties is a participation program for older Australians at participating surf lifesaving clubs throughout Australia promoting physical activity, social connections and involvement in the surf lifesaving community, and Jan Harding is the Umina Surf club contact.

Since the covid lock downs we have found that this type of engagement has been a major benefit to the wellbeing of our elderly who for nearly 12 months felt isolated and disconnected from the community.

Umina Surf Club has a view of engaging with the wider community and the Silver Salties program has provided a perfect framework to implement this easily.

At Umina SLSC and with Jan's leadership we believe the Silver Salties program allows us to build better communities and create great Australians by bringing people together for a shared interest – health and wellbeing.


